



In 2000-2001, I was shortlisted as a finalist for new comer of the year in the British hairdressing awards.

In 2002, I won the Avant garde stylist award in the British hairdressing awards.

From 2002 to 2004, I was the International Coordinator Director for the Artistic Team at Trevor Sorbie.

Involved in every aspect of the business, from the salon floor to in house teaching, from working on international shows to photographic collection shoots, I worked in more then 20 Countries worldwide.

In 2004 for 1 year, I moved to Spain as the International Artistic Director for Tahe Cosmetic. There, with an average of 2 shows per month, I consolidated my name on the international platform.

I returned to London in 2006 to work for Trevor Sorbie for 2 more years, collaborating on three collections and two L'Oreal color trophies until I decided to move to Japan.
